



CAREER CLOTHING CLOSET SIZING GUIDE

Professional attire comes in many sizes, and so do people! While we seek to create a non-gendered closet arrangement, most clothes are still sized according to gender. If you are exploring your clothing choices or are unsure of your sizes, we suggest taking your measurements and using the charts below as a general guide. Take the following measurements while standing.

- Neck _____ (around neck, including two fingers for breathing room)
- Sleeve _____ (midpoint of back of neck, across shoulder, to wrist bone)
- Chest _____ (fullest part of chest, under arms)
- Waist _____ (natural waistline)
- Hip _____ (fullest area, about 7 inches below natural waist)
- Inseam _____ (top of thigh to top of foot)

Some pants are sized according to two numbers: waist measurement x inseam length.
